


Michael Pawlyn Biography and book information

Michael Pawlyn established Exploration Architecture in 2007 to focus on regenerative design. His office has developed ground-breaking projects including The Biomimetic Office, The Zero Waste Textiles Factory and the Mountain Data Centre. Previously he was central to the team at Grimshaw that designed the Eden Project. His TED talk has had over 2 million viewings and his book *Biomimicry in Architecture* has been RIBA Publications' best-selling title.

In 2019 Michael Pawlyn jointly initiated 'Architects Declare a Climate and Biodiversity Emergency' which has spread internationally and now has over six thousand companies signed up to addressing the planetary crisis. He is currently working on a number of environmentally progressive projects and a co-authored book with Sarah Ichioka, titled 'Flourish: Design Paradigms for our Planetary Emergency'.
